### IDT 7078/8078: Mobile Teaching & Learning

This special topics seminar will be focused on the current landscape of mobile teaching and learning. We'll consider devices to support mobile teaching and learning, as well as the instructional strategies and apps that can support a mobile computing initiative. Since this is a seminar, my plan is to offer a more open plan for course goals, so that you may investigate and spend time with a variety of topic of interest to you. I plan to have a significant number of guest speakers from around the country via video conferencing highlight their programs and lessons learned. This course will be **completely online using synchronous conferencing** technologies, so we will meet online Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:30 to 8:30 pm. The course dates are June 4 – July 6, 2011.

### IDT 8500: Evaluation & Synthesis of Research

This doctoral-level course will focus on academic writing. We will work on the structure of scientific reports and how to write for academic audiences. We will critique academic research findings and synthesize research findings into an original, coherent and structured document. This course will **meet face-to-face** and will have time allotted in the course schedule for students to read research and write syntheses of literature. Rest assured, there will be plenty of feedback. This course meets face to face on Mondays and Wednesdays, 5:30 to 8:30 pm. The course dates are June 4 – July 6, 2011.
